### QUARTER TIME

Thirds - 6 minutes,

Reserves - 6 minutes,

Seniors - 6 minutes.

Sounding the Siren – 2 <sup>nd</sup> QUARTER	Siren Blasts
Two (2) minutes prior to scheduled starting time.	Twice (2)
One (1) minute prior to the scheduled starting time.	Once (1)
Start of Quarter.	Once (1)
<i>To End the Second Quarter.</i>	
Sound the siren until the field Umpire brings play to an end.	Once (1)

### HALF TIME

Thirds - 10 minutes,

Reserves - 10 minutes,

Seniors - 20 minutes.

Sounding the Siren – 3 <sup>rd</sup> QUARTER	Siren Blasts
Five (5) minutes prior to scheduled starting time and as Umpires enter the Arena.	Once (1)
Two (2) minutes prior to the scheduled starting time.	Twice (2)
One (1) minute prior to the scheduled starting time.	Once (1)
Start of Quarter.	Once (1)
<i>To End the Third Quarter.</i>	
Sound the siren until the field Umpire brings play to an end.	Once (1)

### THREE QUARTER TIME

Thirds - 6 minutes,

Reserves - 6 minutes,

Seniors - 6 minutes.

Sounding the Siren – 3 <sup>rd</sup> QUARTER	Siren Blasts
Two (2) minutes prior to scheduled starting time.	Twice (2)
One (1) minute prior to the scheduled starting time.	Once (1)
Start of Quarter.	Once (1)
<i>To End the Fourth Quarter.</i>	
Sound the siren until the field Umpire brings play to an end.	Once (1)

### FINISH TIMES

Thirds 11:42am,

Reserves 1:50pm.

### STOPPING THE TIME CLOCK

The Timekeepers shall **only** stop the Time Clock when:-

- directed to do so by a field Umpire in accordance with Law 10.5.3;
- the goal Umpire signals that a Goal has been scored;
- the goal Umpire signals that a Behind has been scored; or
- the boundary Umpire signals that the football is Out of Bounds or Out of Bounds on the Full.
- the field umpire crosses his or her arms to indicate he/she is going to bounce or throw the ball up
